Curriculum

The Cannon Falls Alternative Learning Center offers four levels of core curriculum courses. These classes cover curriculum from 9th grade to 12th grade. Each class is designed to meet the state standards and prepare students for the next level of core competencies.

CFALC offers a wide range of both core and elective courses that will allow students to achieve the goal of high school graduation. We are offering courses such as Art, Math, Civics, World and American History, Music Appreciation, and English.

Credit Recovery

The ALC also provides computer-based classes for those that need to recover credits from previous years. These classes range from entry level English to advanced sciences.

Elective Classes

In addition to core classes, ALC students are given the opportunity to complete elective classes at the ALC or Cannon Falls High School.

Flexible Scheduling

Students may enroll for a full or partial day at the ALC.
